2x Maths copies (7mm squared, 88 pages)
1 Hard Back Ring-Binder Folder with Plastic Pockets and Dividers (kept from 4th Class)

You will also be required to:

- Pay €5 rental for the History and Geography books if you are not in the main Book Rental Scheme.
- Purchase Mary Mother of Hope S.N.S Homework Journal (Each child must use the Mary Mother of Hope Senior School Journal Cost €5)

All children in the school will need the following in their Pencil Cases

- *4 x HB pencils, 1 x pencil sharpener and 2 x erasers
- *2 x red pen, 1 Ruler (30cm),
- *Each child must have set of colouring pencils/crayons.
- *2 x highlighters
- *2 black whiteboard markers (Available in the school shop €1 each)
